- The AT&T Connected Learning Center at MesaCAN provides high-speed internet, computers and education resources for students and families to complete school assignments, participate in virtual learning, look for jobs and more. Free online computer literacy courses are available for children and adults. They are self-paced, and assistance is available onsite to help participants navigate the coursework.
- AT&T and Compudot provide laptops to our low income families.

Programs Offered

- UPchieve (virtual): Students can request online tutoring and college counseling 24/7 from academic coaches.
- Diversity Org (in-person or virtual): Students will attend professional development workshops hosted by AT&T employee panels.
