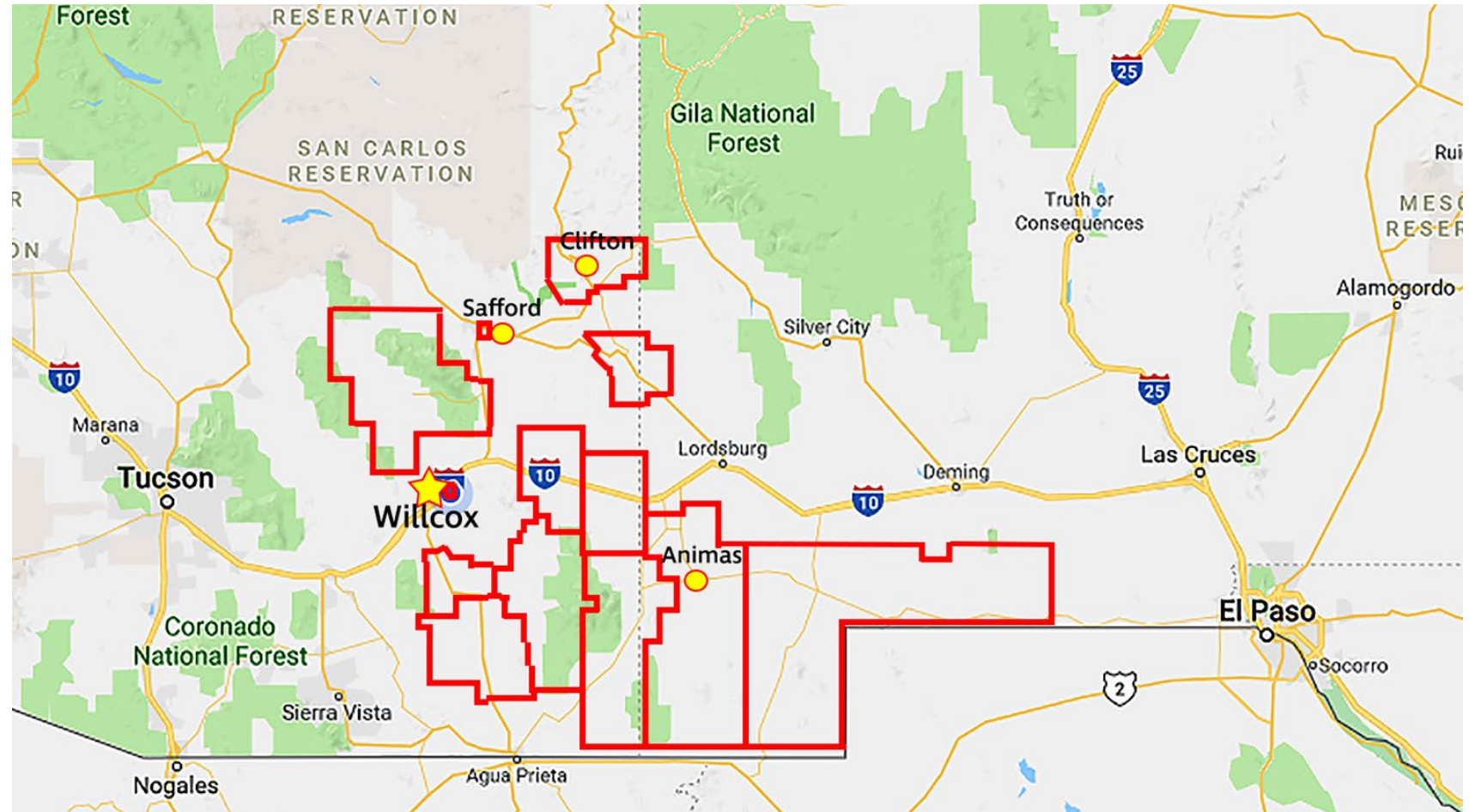

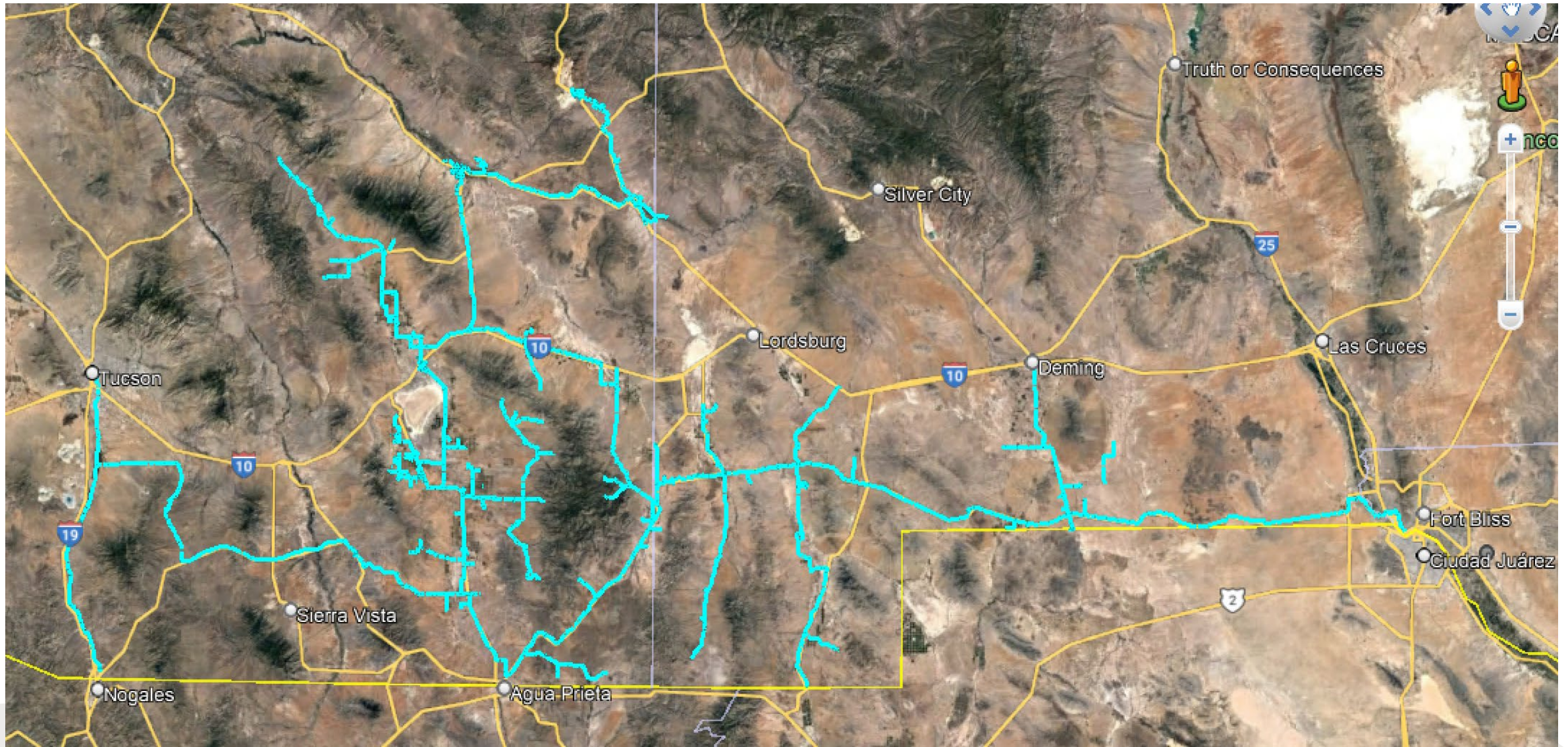




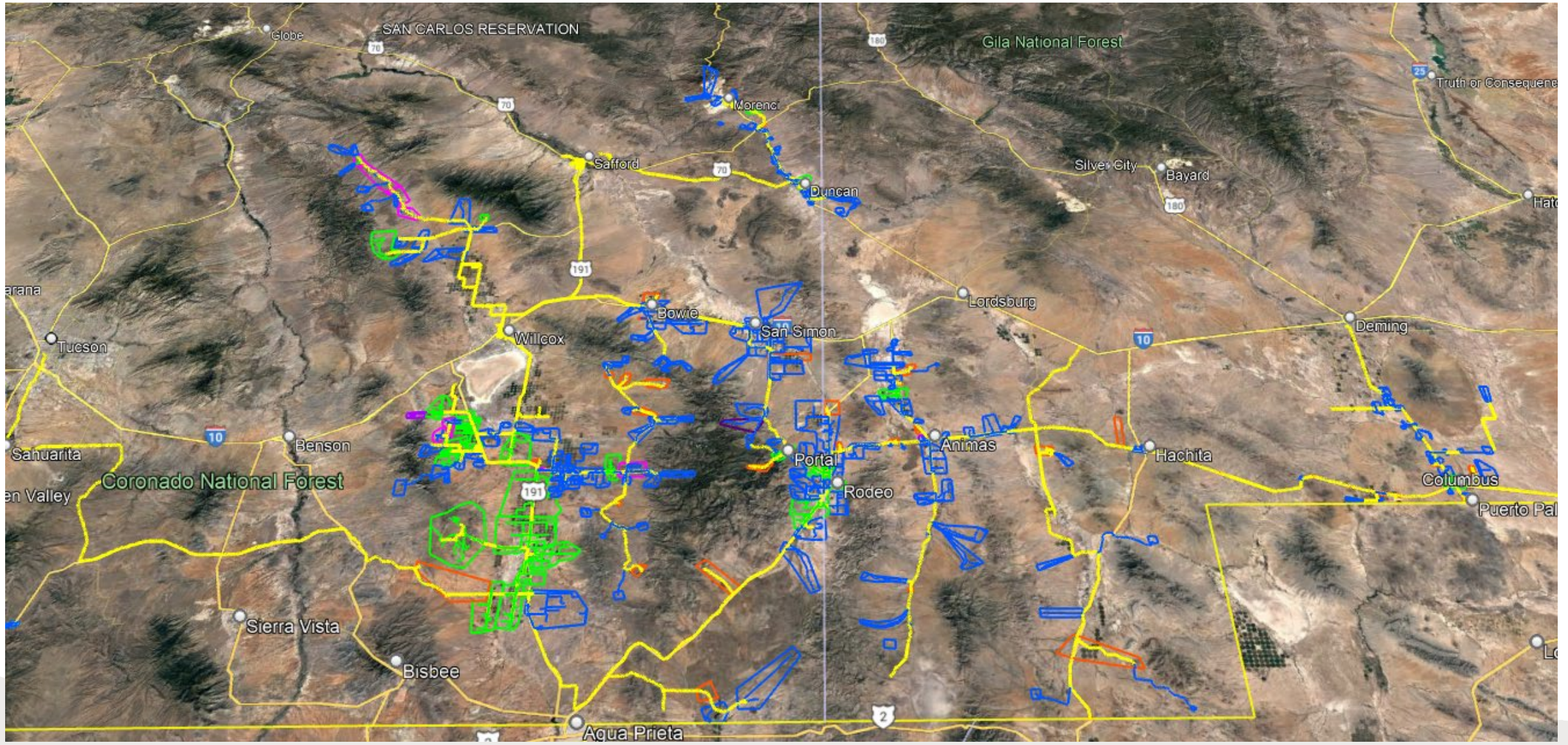
Valley's Long Haul Fiber Map – 300 miles

Alternative Connect America Cost Model (ACAM II)

- **New reimbursement method for Universal Service Funds**
 - Consistent funding over a period of 10-years
 - Commitment to deploy service speeds of 25/3mbps to a specified number of eligible locations
 - Must meet construction bench marks each year
- **Valley opted for ACAM II in 2019**
 - Committed to deploy fiber to 5,152 locations (service up to 1 Gig)
 - Self funded to this point and have connected 40% of the locations
 - \$45M RUS loan to fund the remaining construction
 - Once complete 90% of Valley's ILEC area will be fiber fed

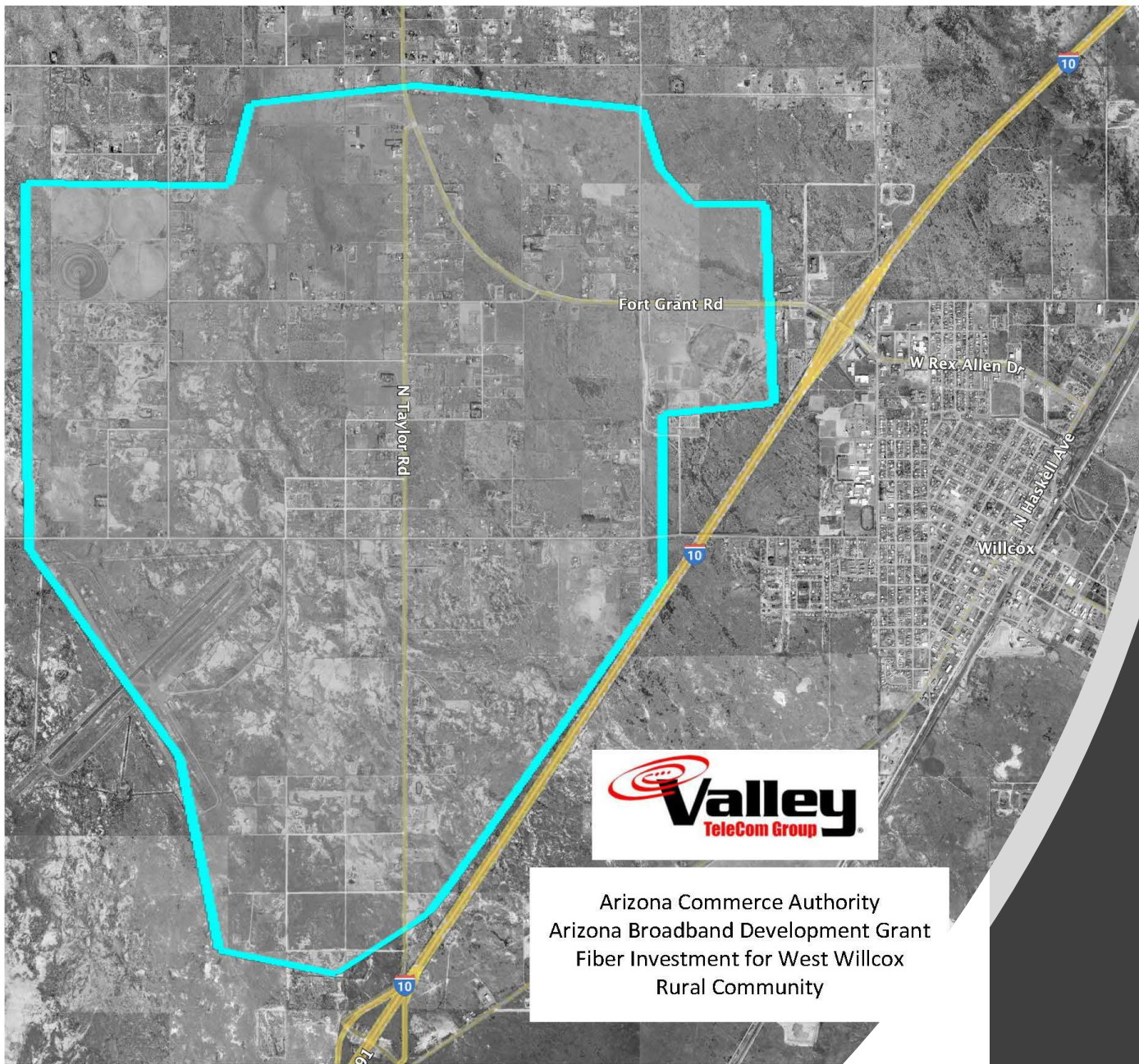

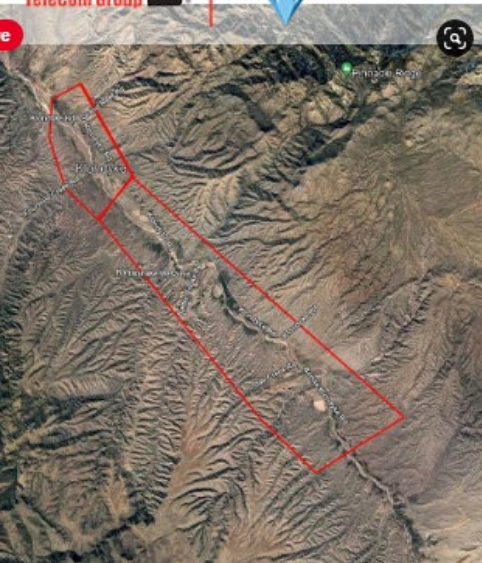

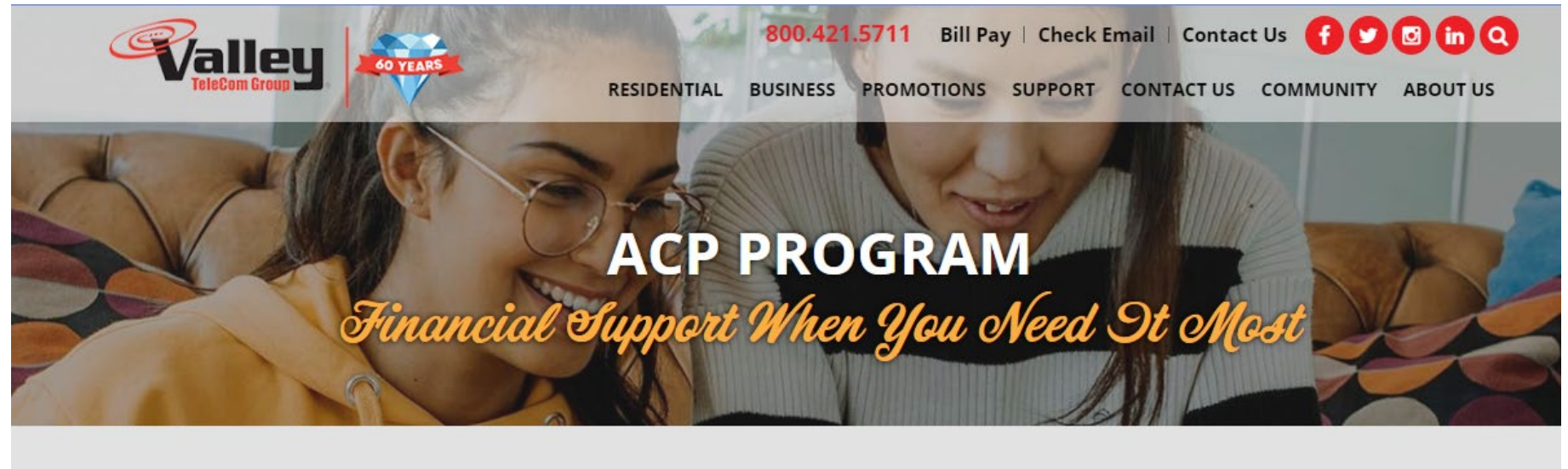

Affordable Connectivity Program

At Valley TeleCom, it's vital that everyone has access to affordable internet, so they can stay connected. The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is a Government funded program administered by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) that replaces the Emergency Broadband Benefit Program to help low-income households pay for internet service.

ACP Outreach

School & Education Support

- Proactively placed fiber to 17 Schools in the past 5 years
- Donated \$10,000 to each school purchase equipment to facilitate learning at home in 2020
 - (10 accepted the offer)
- Scholarships granted in excess of \$125,000 annually
 - \$1.5 Million since program started in 2003
