


STRATEGIC GOAL

- Nearly 1,130,000 students attend publicly funded K-12 schools in Arizona
- Arizona has almost 110,000 certified K-12 teachers, 60,322 of them currently serve in public schools. School self-reports suggest that 79% of certified teachers are experienced (3+ years in their position). https://azreportcards.azed.gov/state-reports

Four Year Graduation Rate

The "Four-year graduation rate" is the percentage of students who graduated within the first 4 years of enrolling in high school.




