### Care Beyond Walls and Wires: In-home monitoring

Using remote monitoring tools, this program is designed to improve the quality of life for people with chronic health conditions, helping patients and families get the care they need without leaving home.

With daily access to information including blood pressure, weight and symptoms of illness, care teams and patients can co-manage treatment plans. It's also possible to detect changes in a patient's health status early on and intervene at the right time to avoid unnecessary travel and hospital care.

## Case Study

More than 5 million people in the U.S. suffer from congestive heart failure (CHF), a Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). The annual cost is estimated at more than \$10 billion in medications, and lost earnings, the CDC says. Northern Arizona Healthcare's "Care Beyond Walls and Wires" can improve CHF patients' health and reduce health care costs.

Woody Smith and his daughter, Rita Yazzie, used to drive as often as twice a month from their home on the Navajo Reservation to Flagstaff Medical Center, nearly two hours away. Mr. Smith is living with congestive heart failure, with symptoms so severe he required frequent hospitalizations.

But Mr. Smith can now stay at home for months without having to go to the hospital. His condition has resulted from a program called Care Beyond Walls and Wires, a telemedicine-enabled program that has improved the health of patients with congestive heart failure.

The program also reduces room visits and readmissions, and saves money for those who stay for those who are discharged.

"It's phenomenal," says a registered nurse for Flagstaff-based Northern Arizona Healthcare, which runs the Walls and Wires program at Flagstaff Medical Center.

Ms. Yazzie says the program "is the best thing for my dad. He's been in two hospital readmissions since the program more than a year ago."

And at 90, Mr. Smith has been able to return to his favorite activity: riding his horse.

Care Beyond Walls and Wires provides patients with a backpack containing the equipment they need to check their blood pressure, measure their oxygen level, and check their weight daily; the latter because patients with CHF can gain and drop weight suddenly. The data are automatically

transferred to a smart phone that transmits the information to Northern Arizona Healthcare's care coordination office, which provides the smart phone, monitoring equipment and backpack to every patient enrolled in Care Beyond Walls and Wires.

Some of the program's patients have no electricity at home, so they also are given a battery-powered phone.

The San Diego telecommunications company Qualcomm was chosen to lead the project, with Maryland-based Zephyr Technology and Verizon providing software, smart phones and remote-monitoring hardware.

Northern Arizona Healthcare agreed to conduct a pilot project involving 50 patients. The project got under way in January.

Care Beyond Walls and Wires ended on January 1, 2010. Northern Arizona Healthcare is continuing the program.



## UA Researchers Using Telemedicine to Tackle Asthma in Tucson School Children

Each weekday morning at 20 Tucson elementary schools, more than 260 children with asthma report to their school nurse or health aid. Each child is given their own corticosteroid inhaler, inhales the medication, then returns to class.

The children are part of a multi-year, NIH-funded study of an asthma prevention program that is school-based for a number of reasons. The study was launched in the fall of 2014 in 20 schools in the Tucson Unified School District (TUSD).

Asthma is one of the most common chronic diseases of childhood, affecting about 10 percent of children in the U.S. It's also described as the most common cause of school absenteeism due to illness, according to the Centers for Disease Control and

## ATIC DHS WiFi Security Project for First Responders

This project is one of several national information technology demonstration grants awarded by the Information Technology and Evaluation Program (ITEP) of the [Department of Homeland Security \(DHS\)](#) in 2004. It is a "proof of concept" to initiate Phase I of securing Wireless Broadband (WiFi) along a 30 mile corridor between Rio Rico and Green Valley, Arizona (see [full size image](#) [340k JPEG]). It utilizes existing and new 802.11x access points, strategically placed for rural users, including law enforcement, first responders, or civilians, to obtain broadband connectivity along the corridor. Corridor users will have access while mobile. The long term plan calls for expanding the end-user categories to include private individuals, businesses and organizations along the corridor, who do not have broadband connectivity today.

The [Arizona Telecommunications and Information Council \(ATIC\)](#) is leading the implementation effort for the Award Grantee, the [Arizona Division of Emergency Management \(ADEM\)](#).

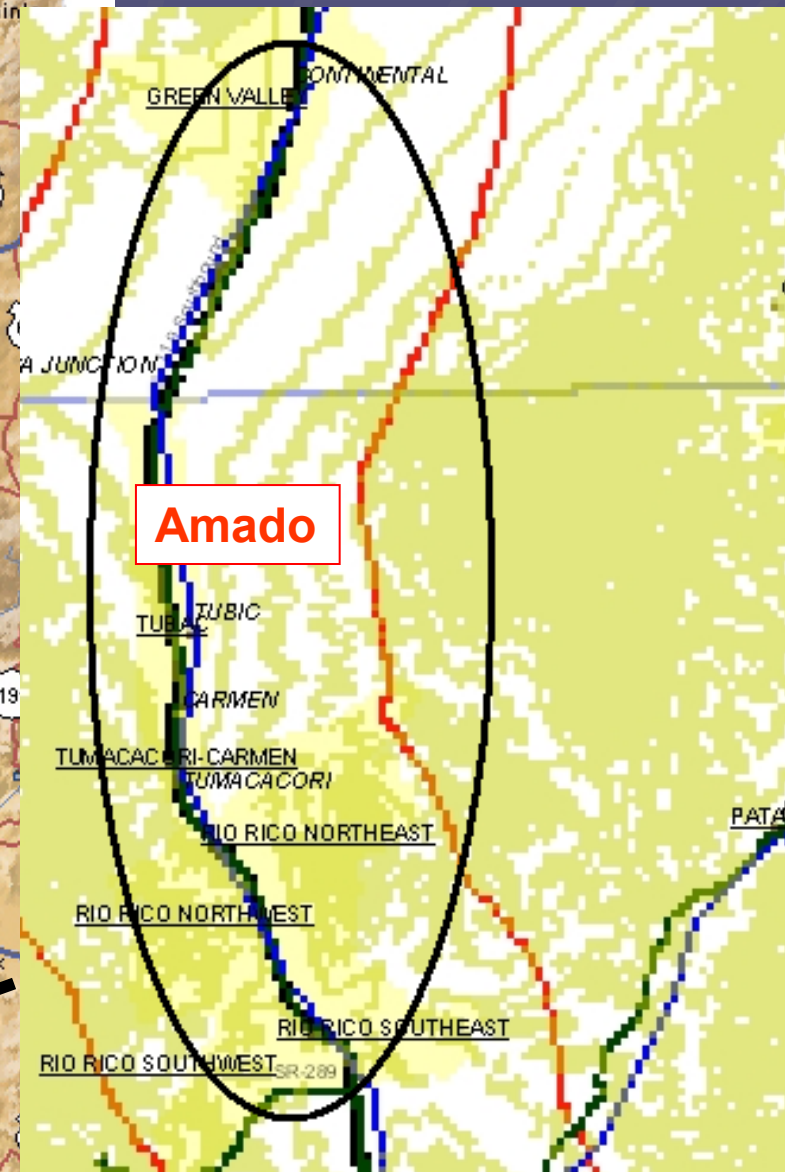
### Here are some additional details on the project.

A 30-mile stretch of the CANAMEX Corridor near Mexico will be "secured" as a First Responder WiFi "hot spot" with sufficient access points to enable in-vehicle "WiFi ready" devices moving into and through the area to have mobile access to the Internet or Internet based Virtual Private Networks (VPNs), and with various applications associated with those resources, at broadband (1 Mbps+) speeds.

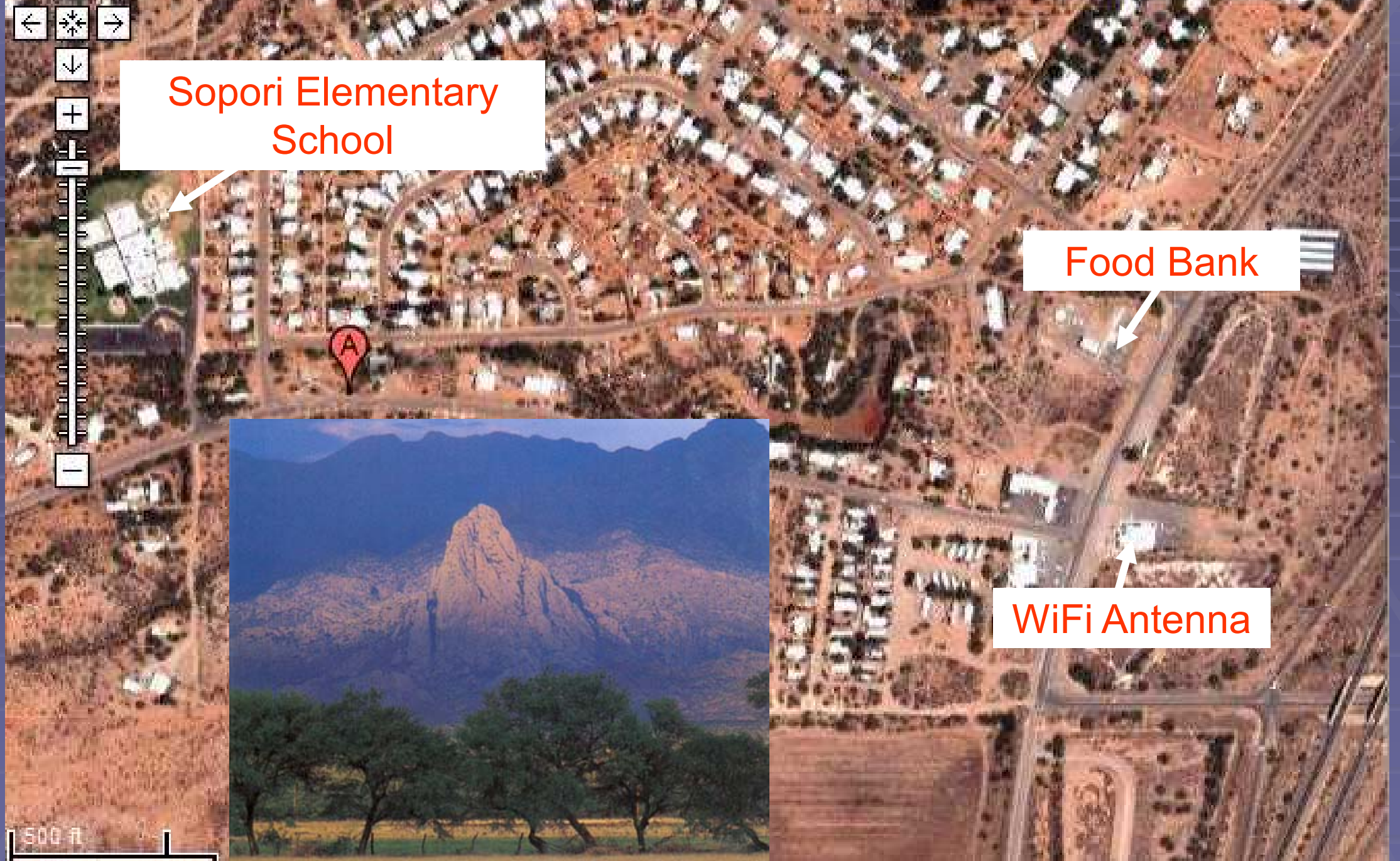
