I thought, then I got a free afternoon. I'm just gonna just be a fly in the wall here. What's going on in Arizona?

Here's what we got right now. I just want to lead with mapping.

Now for those of us working on the deployment side.

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:10:24

We had asked for corrections earlier on a month to help people articulate changes in front of bead deadlines, but that being said, we are still taking challenges, and I think we will never stop thinking challenges, because some app broadband map will be an ever changing thing right right now what there are no people there will

be people. At some point, people who do not have access to brought that where there are people without access to Broadway there will be people with access to broadband, and so we will be forever changing the maps. Again.

The maps. Accuracy has everything to do with eligibility for Usda, for all the other big Grant programs.

Hmm.

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:11:15

For deployment. That community is built for deployment.

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:11:20

So please, by all means chat. Did you challenge our maps?

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:11:28

And I have an offer. If you'll want, I can get you one of our maps specialists to give you 10 min at any time.

If you give me 2 weeks notice, and she's a great presenter.

She shares her screen. She will teach you how to challenge maps.

And now we're all Johnny at Janie Apple C, and we get spread word to everybody.

In Arizona, and beyond new subject. So today we confirmed that this is, for this is, by the way, we're all friends.

This is not for attribution, or for the press, or anybody else.

Right. This is only among us. We confirm that the Chairwoman is going to be in Arizona on February fourteenth.

Here's the plan that I know of on February fourteenth, somewhere around tennis, she'll be doing a press conference at the Mayor of Phoenix.

Followed by a trade Acp. Train, the trainer for librarians.

Formed up, from the Phoenix area to help consumers understand acp, and also how to enroll, so that's gonna we're gonna to me like me and my teammate are gonna run that after the press conference, the chairwoman and the Mayor will take in the first 5 or 10

Minutes of it. Then the chairwoman has a 2 different one or 2 different tribal library visits the tribal library, portfolio is really important to the children right now.

Separately. Then, after we

Excuse me, I'll our people welcome to attend that, or is it close

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:13:22

That is non public. So both things are non-public.

[Steve Peters] 15:13:24

Okay.

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:13:30

This is just information only because you guys are a zoning separately on the public side of the house.

[Steve Peters] 15:13:32

Okay.

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:13:36

We are. We just found this out like just like an hour ago.

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:13:40

So we are going to try to use your taxpayer dollars that you fly us around wisely.

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:13:45

We are going to probably spend an afternoon in Phoenix, and we're kicking around wholeing an Acp enrollment event in meeting Room or Hilton Garden in, or something like that, where we're gonna get people who are eligible and not enrolled and help them to roll

Directly with a bank of computers that we're gonna bring from DC, so

My ask is, since we're here, and I'm asking if anybody wants to work together on this good different parts that we can play together.

I, am going to bring the computer in the trainer and the room.

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:14:30

If we can work together, with our contacts to get low income Acp, qualified people, understanding that we're gonna be there I'll run a press release out of Fcc and we'll have the chairwoman and then here pitch this on the fourteenth but I would I don't

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:14:52

I wanna since I'm there. For a couple of days.

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:14:54

I wanna serve the public, my public. So the one if we don't do an enrollment event, I am also open to to an Acp train.

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:15:06

The trainer event like this group. I'm happy to sit you down in the room and show you how the enrollment process works.

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:15:14

Talk about a train, the trainer, and turn you into Janie and Johnny Apple seeds for the seat of Arizona.

So that's the fourteenth. On in the afternoon.

We're thinking because of working for consumers, of going 4 to 8 pm.

In Phoenix, said, Look, location! I can lock down, probably in next 2 days, and then separately.

We are going to stay on the fifteenth to and go into Tucson right now.

We have a a scheduling interest from the Tucson Mayor's office to have a non public meeting.

I am thinking about pitching them to the same thing.

[JONATHAN BOUTILIER] 15:15:58

Yup!

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:16:01

A press conference on the front end except the chair. One would be there to be just Lyle, and then a train.

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:16:08

The trainer for Tucson, sitting employees who work with people who are low income, followed by a public facing enrollment or I'll awareness or train the trainer event in Tucson, for which, again, I have the means to get a room.

Sure.

I just. I'm not quite sure yet. This is just an hour tool how?

Yeah, I had a suggestion is talked about using a hotel, for instance, and and when we're talking about low income folks travel on access to travel, to be able to get to where they need to be is going to be extremely difficult within Phoenix we know, there are communities areas where that we've got a lot

[Paul Ross] 15:17:13

of low income people. So I'm thinking, and the potential applicants for Acp is not utilizing us a hotel, but maybe look at a one of the high schools in the high school school school district here where they have a lot of parking available and I have facilities.

So maybe that might be a better option rather than a hotel.

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:17:34

Hi, yeah, I'm okay. I I'm not not the hotel.

[Lyle Ishida (FCC)] 15:17:38

The only reason we use these hotels is because it's logistically easier when you're on a short time.

Frame. Right? I can just contract out a room and do it.

However, in areas that you know locally, which I don't, cause, it's submitted to me right when I look at Arizona.

They come into flavors, one to the outreach transferred to general public, and one to do tribal outreach for for how?

For residents of travel lands. We anticipate to have in announcement out for grantees.

Probably no later than mid-march. It's a really short timeline.

So I got my entire division working on pre screening and Strads applications to hear plentiful.

So that's going on as well as we have a couple of pilot programs as well, and we'll be announcing them as well in mid March, and then

Not on the Acp side, but on digital equity and anti-discrimination, anti-digital discrimination portfolio that that she has.

My team is working on 3 different missing sessions for the anti-discrimination portfolio which anti-digital discrimination portfolio we'll be announcing them.

So we were not only giving them, helping them get Internet. We were also giving them computers, so that we kind of had that total solution.

So now you know, on onwards to today with Acp we went for the grant we were looking at, trying to do it in all of our States. Right?

I said there was a need, and we'd have the connection with our program.

We realize we wouldn't be able to do that. There just was not enough funding to do that.

So we're not only going to do it all our states, but we're also going to be Puerto Rico, because we do have services that we're starting over there.

So we took out Puerto Rico, and we took out Texas, and so we looked at is where we are going to hire somebody to to to manage this because the way we met with each of our presidents of our States and we started talking to this, like how would this work and what kind of resources would

We have. So we work through this, and we realize that through our programs we will be able in and this is something that we've been doing here in Arizona.

And so it worked out pretty well because a lot of them were getting services at our site, so they would just come into our sites, and then we would set up some computers and tablets depending on where we're at.

And they shied away from it. A lot of them are monolingual.

And so a lot of times they would ask their kids, who are younger, to go and help them fill out the documents and then they would get confused and have issues as they were trying to fill that out, so they shied away from it.

So we found that, you know, just handholding them through.

It was kind of the best process for our families and in the communities that we serve.
