Timeline



- **Fall 2024:** Develop clinic model
 - Develop curriculum, process, procedures, policies
 - Identify pilot student participants
 - Identify pilot clients (organization involvement)
- **Spring 2025:** Pilot
 - Aligned with spring academic semester
 - Up to 30 students
 - Up to 10 organizations
 - Remote / In-Person
- **Ongoing Operations:**
 - Currently scheduled through 2031
 - Aligned with academic semesters (fall / spring)
 - Explore persistent model (year-round support)
 - Expanding services
 - Funding for student workers
