Meeting Notes:

Introductions (All)

- Attendees introduced themselves.
- Several were guests from New Mexico and California concerned with Navajo Nation and cross-state broadband issues and collaboration.

Mission of the Arizona Telehealth Broadband Action Team (Jeff Sobotka)

- Jeff has set up several Broadband Action Teams (BATs) in communities across Arizona.
- The telehealth BAT is statewide & focused on needs of telehealth providers & patients.
- Goal: collaboration & potential ideas on how to improve broadband access for telehealth in the state.

Group discussion regarding Navajo Nation broadband infrastructure challenges, issues, & funding followed.

Update: Federal Broadband Grant Program (Jeff Sobotka)

- Jeff reviewed available federal & state broadband grant opportunities, including the FCC COVID-19 Telehealth
 Program, the USDA DLT & RUS grants, the NIH, Economicic Development Administration, Arzona Rural
 Broadband Development Grants, and potential additional federal stimulus funding.
- Many application deadlines have past; others are coming up soon.

Group discussion on funding & social determinants of health, including lack of broadband access, followed. It was suggested to bring funding for social determinants into this picture.
